A tsunami (soo-NAH-mee) is a series of ocean waves. Tsunamis are mostly caused by earthquakes.

Tsunami Warning Signs:

- Unusual disappearance of water at the ocean
- A strong earthquake that makes people fall down or lasts for 20 seconds or more
- Hear a loud ocean roar

If a tsunami occurs, keep calm and immediately move inland to higher ground.

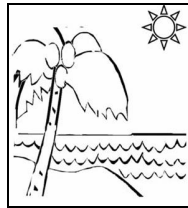
